ELIGIBILITY

All contestants must be at least 50 years of age on or before May 29, 2018. See professional entry priority on page 2.

*There is no handicap limit for amateurs, but a maximum index of 24.0 will be allowed for the competition for those players exceeding this index. See reverse side for complete eligibility details. The revision in effect on May 16, 2018 will be used for this championship.

COMPETITION

Championship consists of 54 holes of stroke play, with gross and net payouts for professionals, super senior professionals (60+), and four age divisions of amateurs. There is a concurrent 36-hole pro-am competition, using one gross ball and one net ball at 90% handicap. Payouts are weighted toward the gross prizes. Amateurs are limited to winnings of \$750, including skins, for the entire championship. Metal spikes are not allowed.

CARTS

Dungeness has an ample supply of carts for the event. Carts will be \$36 per day. 360-683-6344. You will pay through the pro shop.

MOTEL RESERVATIONS

The Quality Inn & Suites in Sequim, a tournament sponsor, has blocked rooms for participants at a promotional rate. The deadline for the block is May 1. See page 2 of entry form.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The application included on the reverse side hereof is subject to acceptance by the PNW Section, PGA of America, and applicant agrees that in the event of its acceptance, it may be rejected or revoked at any time thereafter. To be accepted, entries must be signed, paid, and received at Tournament Headquarters. Therefore, players submitting entries are encouraged to allow ample time for delay or error in transmission of their entries.

Both the said Application and Applicant's participation in the aforesaid Invitational Championship (hereafter referred to as the "Championship") are subject to all Rules, Regulations, provisions of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Pacific Northwest Section, PGA of America and other conditions applicable to the Championship, as well as to the terms and conditions of the agreement between the PNW Section, PGA of America and the Championship sponsor(s) with respect to same.

NON-METAL SPIKE RELEASE (if facility is spikeless): It is the requirement of the Host Club that all individuals using the Host Club golf course wear spikeless/non-metal golf shoes. This requirement is a policy of the Host Club and is not a policy of the Pacific Northwest Section of the PGA of America ("Section"). The use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes may result in the participant slipping on wet or damp surfaces (inclusive of but not necessarily limited to turf area, wooden areas such as bridges and pathways, etc.) and reduced traction on non-level areas of the golf course. As evidenced by the participant's signature on the front of this entry, the participant acknowledges that potential dangers relative to the use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes have been disclosed to participant and participant agrees to assume the risk of sustaining injury arising from or attributable to the use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes at the Host Club's premises. The participant here releases the Section and Section's officers, directors, members, employees, successors and assigns (the "Indemnified Parties") from any and all claims for loss damage, inclusive of but not limited to personal injury, whether or not caused by participant's use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes at the Host Club's premises in connection with the tournament. The consideration for this release is the permission granted by Section to the participant to participate in the golf tournament. This release binds not only the participant, but also the participant's spouse, heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

By this application, an applicant consents to references to him and pictures of him and his play in any publicity, radio and television broadcasting and other exhibition or publication, including their use in any commercial manner.

ELIGIBLE PLAYERS: The term "eligible player" is defined, for this Championship, as: (1) all Pacific Northwest Section, PGA of America members (except those classified as "F" or "Inactive"); (2) all PNW Section, PGA of America apprentices with full Section Playing Privileges; (3) amateurs as defined by the USGA with a recognized USGA or BCGA handicap index. All players must reach their 50th birthday on or before May 30, 2017. Contestants entering as amateurs may not accept professional prize money. Section 5 of the PNW PGA Tournament Regulations applies.

56 TEAMS; ENTRY PRIORITY WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

WAITING LIST AND FILLING OPEN SPOTS ON TEAMS

Entry is a **Team** entry and therefore professionals entering a complete team will be given priority. The following rules for incomplete teams are adopted for 2018:

- Three weeks (May 8) prior to the start of the tournament, the professional may ask the WWC Executive Director for one player to help fill his team. The Director will assign the highest ranking professional on the waiting list who chooses to abandon his/her own team to join the team needing a player. If there are no professionals waiting to play, or none who choose to abandon their team, the highest priority amateur (on a first to call-in basis) on the wait list will be assigned. The Director will only furnish one player to any team.
- Two weeks (May 15) prior to the tournament, the professional of any unfilled team will be placed at the top of the wait list and be replaced in the field with the highest professional on the wait list having a full team.
- Notwithstanding the above rules, the Director may assign a waiting list professional or amateur to any team that loses a player within the week prior to the tournament.
- No professional may add into a team more than once every four years. No professional shall add a professional to his team more than once every four years. No team shall have, under any circumstance, more than two professionals among its players.

STARTING TIMES: Starting times will be available on the WWC website and the golf course on Friday, May 25. Competitors are responsible for knowing their starting time and tee.

DRESS CODE: Contestants may not wear jeans. Professionals may not wear shorts or skirts (amateurs may wear shorts).

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Any day by reservation. Special \$34 rate for amateurs Mon-Thur; \$40 Fri-Sun & Memorial Day

NON-METAL SPIKES: It is a condition of the competition that metal spikes are prohibited. Traction systems using any form of metal spike will be prohibited. Penalty for Breach - *Disqualification*.

HUDSON CUP POINTS: The appropriate Senior Hudson Cup points will be granted by the Section, OGA, and WSGA for this event.

SEPARATE TEE POLICY: Although competing from separate tees, men and women shall compete for the same purse.
